The New Overtime Rule: What You Need to Know (and Do) Now

The U.S. Department of Labor recently published significant changes to the overtime rule that will make approximately 4.2 million additional employees eligible for overtime pay as of December 1, 2016. Employees who earn less than \$47,476 per year will have to be paid overtime, no matter what position they hold, more than doubling the current \$23,660 salary currently required to qualify as an exempt employee (i.e., not eligible for overtime). The new overtime rule is likely to impact not-for-profit organizations in many ways (i.e., board meeting attendance, fund-raising events, executive director salaries, etc.).
